Hepburn Health Service (HHS), in partnership with Dental Health Services Victoria (DHSV) are providing your members the opportunity to invest in a customised mouthguard as a preventative health strategy for 2018.

The customised mouthguards, manufactured by a qualified Dental Prosthetist are available in club colours and will be ready for collection approximately 2 weeks after the impressions have been taken.

Eligibility and costs are as follows:

Age	Eligibility	Cost
12 and under	Must have a minimum of 4 front adult teeth	Free
13-17	A holder or dependant of a current Concession Card  Healthcare Card  Pensioner Concession Card	Free
18 and above	A holder of a current Concession Card  Healthcare Card  Pensioner Concession Card	\$28
13 and above	IF NOT a dependant or holder of a current Concession Card  • Maybe eligible for a rebate if privately insured.	\$100



#### **HEALTHY TIPS**

Flossing in between your teeth removes food debris and plaque from in between the teeth that a toothbrush can't reach. The 5 steps below show you how to correctly floss your teeth:

- Everyone should floss, including children. Flossing should begin as soon as two teeth are touching. It should be done at least once a day.
- Use enough floss so that you can wrap it around your middle fingers. Use your thumbs and index fingers to guide the floss.
- Gently ease the floss between two teeth and form a 'C' shape against the surface of one tooth.
- Pull the floss so that it is tight around the tooth and gently guide it up and down from the chewing surface to under the gum. Repeat for each side on all teeth. Don't forget to floss the back of your last teeth.
- Samples of floss products available from supermarkets and pharmacies.


