

Library

Purpose

To provide and maintain Library resources to support the school programs at Daylesford Primary School.

To provide each student with access to a wide range of literature and resource material, and encourage the view that libraries can be lifelong resources of value.

Guidelines

Library resources will be purchased to support the school's curriculum programs.

Acquisition of new materials will be guided by an attempt to reflect the diversity of Australian society.

The library staff will monitor resources to ensure that they are up-to-date and in good working order.

Students will have regular access to library resources and the opportunity to borrow.

Borrowers who lose books will be asked to contribute 50% of the replacement cost of the book.

Evaluation

Minor: A minor review is to be completed annually with program budgets.

Major: A major review is to be conducted in line with the whole school plan.
