

The COVID-19 virus and the restrictions that have arisen from it have resulted in our schools moving to a remote learning model. Our Teachers have completed their planning for the start of term two and will be delivering lessons in a combination of digital learning and hard copy materials.

Our remote learning platforms allow for online assessments and also other assessments that teachers develop. Feedback in the learning process is important so our teachers will remain committed to giving feedback on learning tasks on a regular basis.

Structure is important for students and their parents. Each unit (Prep, 1-2, 3-4, 5-6) will provide direction as to the logistics of the day. Initially this will be a strong emphasis on Literacy, Numeracy and physical activity. As we get into the flow of things we will bring Integrated Studies, STEM and the Arts into our learning program.

Certainly the partnership between school and home has never been more important. We ask that parents support the engagement of their children with the learning tasks set by the teacher. We also welcome any feedback or communication with our staff on how we can help our students and parents.
