Current Focus

'Empathy'

(Caring & Compassion)

Emotional intelligence is the ability to understand how your emotions impact on the way you think, communicate, behave and influence others. Emotionally intelligent people create effective working relationships, solve problems and have an increased capacity to work effectively.

It's healthy to have positive and negative feelings. They help us to identify our reactions to the way we think about ourselves, others and the world around us.

Empathy and compassion are habits that can be developed. They are a fundamental building block for good personal development and positive mental health for all. It happens when one person has a caring emotional response to someone else.

To be empathic a person needs to be able to:

- Understand their own feelings/emotions
- Notice the feelings of another person
- Understand the feelings of another person
- Act in a caring way.

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STEM CAMP

On Monday 6th June, 5 students and 2 teachers met at Woodend station to travel to Melbourne for a 3-day STEM extension camp. The camp is part of a term long STEM extension program. We work in small groups with people from other schools, each group has two mentors from Year Ten.

On our first day, we travelled to the Melbourne Museum in our mentor groups, and we ran around looking at the different exhibits on a scavenger hunt. Then we went back to where we were staying and did a trivia contest before bed. I liked the museums and the scavenger hunt. The lunch food wasn't as good as the other food but that was fine. The rooms were good, the views were great.

On day two the mentor trivia was fun. We had to guess which mentor matched the "Fun Fact". After that we went to the Australian portraiture exhibit, which had heaps of different paintings and abstract and Aboriginal art. Later, we did about 4 different science experiments at Macrob Girls High which was quite interesting and then when we got back to the CYC we got into our mentor groups and did an engineering challenge, where you had 50 pieces of paper and a role of tape and you had to work with a group to create the tallest tower. Then after dinner, we watched a movie.

On the third day, we packed up our things and spent the day exploring the Immigration Museum and city arcades as well as a delicious dumpling lunch in Chinatown.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

PARENTS, DO YOU HAVE A VALID MEANS-TESTED CONCESSION CARD?

Then you may be eligible to apply for the CSEF (CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSION FUND)

CONVEYANCE ALLOWANCE

Are you eligible?

For students to be eligible for a conveyance allowance they must:

- Be aged over five by 30th April 2022.
- Live more than 4.8km by the **shortest practicable** route from the nearest bus stop, and be enrolled at the nearest government school

OPPORTUNITY FOR PROFESSIONAL CUSTOMISED MOUTHGUARDS

Central Highlands Rural Health (CHRH), in partnership with Dental Health Services Victoria (DHSV) are providing your members/students, who participate in a contact sport, the opportunity to invest in a customised mouthguard as a preventative health strategy for 2022.

The customised mouthguards, manufactured by a qualified Dental Prosthetist are available in club colours and will be ready for collection approximately 2 weeks after the impressions have been taken.

Eligibility and costs are as follows:

Age	Eligibility	Cost
12 and under	Must have a minimum of 4 front adult teeth	Free
13 – 17	A holder or dependant of a current Concession Card <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Healthcare Card Pensioner Concession Card 	Free
18 and above	A holder of a current Concession Card <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Healthcare Card Pensioner Concession Card 	\$30.00
13 and above	IF NOT a dependant or holder of a current Concession Card <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Maybe eligible for a rebate if privately insured. 	\$150

NOTE: ALL IMPRESSIONS THIS YEAR WILL BE TAKEN IN BALLARAT

- In the first instance you are required to register with the Oral Health Department at CHRH on 5321 6580. Your voucher will then be sent to the Ballarat Denture Clinic.
- Secondly, you are required to phone the Ballarat Denture Clinic on: 5331 6486 to arrange an appointment time for your impression in Ballarat. The BDC is located at 18 Raglan Street North, Ballarat.
- Thirdly, you will be able to pick up your mouthguard from CHRH Community Health and Wellbeing Centre within 7-14 days after your impression.


