# FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

PARENTS, DO YOU HAVE A VALID MEANS-TESTED **CONCESSION CARD?** Then you may be eligible to apply for the CSEF (CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSION FUND)

Eligibility will be subject to the parent/carer's concession card being successfully validated with Centrelink on the first day of either term one (27<sup>TH</sup> Jan 2023) or term two (24th April 2023). The annual CSEF amount per primary student will be \$125, which will be paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.





- 1. In the first instance, you are required to register with the Oral Health Department at CHRH on 5321 6580. If you are eligible, your voucher will then be sent to the Ballarat Denture Clinic.
- 2. Once registered with the Oral Health Department at CHRH, you will be required to phone the Ballarat Denture Clinic on: 5331 6486 to arrange an appointment time for your impression in Ballarat. The BDC is located at 18 Raglan Street North, Ballarat.
- 3. You will be able to collect your mouthguard from CHRH Community Health and Wellbeing Centre within 7-14 days after your impression.
