



- In the first instance, you are required to register with the Oral Health Department at CHRH on 5321 6580. If you are eligible, your <u>voucher</u> will then be sent to the Ballarat Denture Clinic.
- Once registered with the Oral Health Department at CHRH, you will be required to phone the Ballarat Denture Clinic on: 5331 6486 to arrange an appointment time for your impression in Ballarat. The BDC is located at 18 Raglan Street North, Ballarat.
- 3. You will be able to collect your mouthguard from CHRH Community Health and Wellbeing Centre within 7-14 days after your impression.
