# Writing

Across the school we have had a focus on writing and pleasingly our local assessment and broader assessment are showing improvement! ## **NAPLAN**

Individual NAPLAN results will be coming home for students in grades three and five in the next couple of weeks. This year, a new system has been implemented at a national level with four proficiency standards for each year level. This replaces the old system where 10 bands were used across all testing levels, grade three through to year nine. More information on this will be sent home with your child/ren's individual NAPLAN report.

# **Assembly**

Starting next week, we are moving our assembly time forward just a smidge! Assembly will begin at 2.30pm which will allow teachers time to take their class back to rooms to collect their bags for dismissal. 

# Come and Try Orienteering in Daylesford Saturday 22nd July Proudly Supported by VicHealth

If you or your family like Treasure Hunts, solving problems or just getting outside and walking/running then this could be the sport for you. Orienteering is a sport where competitors navigate their way around a set of checkpoints or controls. It adds another challenge to just going for a walk or run because the fastest isn't always the winner. You can participate as an individual, in pairs or family groups. Explore areas like Cornish Hill in brand new ways.

# How does it work?/How do I get involved?

The Saturday event is a Come and Try it event where we will have coaches to help you. You just turn up ready to run or walk and someone will show you how it works. We'll explain how the maps work, what you are looking for and what you need to do. If you have a compass, please bring it but we will have some available and for your first event, it isn't necessary.

We'll give you a specially prepared map with a series of checkpoints marked by purple circles on the map. You navigate your way to each circle in turn and at each checkpoint there will be an orange and white flag and a punch so you can register that you got there. Then you navigate to the next one and so on, until you get to the finish.

The come and try it and beginner courses will be designed to take walkers 40 minutes and runners 20-30 minutes. It's better if children under 12 go with an adult or their families for their first try and others may want to run as a pair.

- You will be able to collect your mouthguard from CHRH Community Health and Wellbeing Centre within 7-14 days after your impression.
