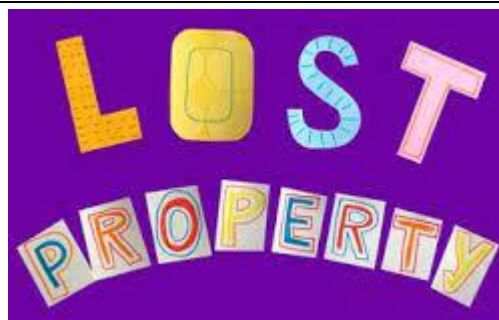

**For your Information – Excursion Permission**
