For your Information – Excursion Permission

Permission to attend excursions must be received by returning a signed form, a handwritten permission note or electronic permission as per DEET policy.

Late Arrival and Early Departure

Cafs' Family Support Team want to help:


- The health and wellbeing of your children and family.
