Goldfields Cross Country



Every time a family purchases books through Book Club the school receives





Volleyball for Junior, grade 6 students restarts this year on Monday 5th February at 6 pm.




The competitions are also run by Victorian State Junior Coach Colin Priest and his band of coaches.
