Late Arrival and Early Departure

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

PARENTS, DO YOU HAVE A VALID MEANS-TESTED CONCESSION CARD? Then you may be eligible to apply for the CSEF (CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSION FUND)

Eligibility will be subject to the parent/carer's concession card being successfully validated with Centrelink on the first day of either term one (29TH Jan 2024) or term two (15th April 2024). The annual CSEF amount per primary student will be \$125, which will be paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.





- In the <u>first instance</u>, you are required <u>to register</u> with the Oral Health Department at CHRH on 5321 6580. If you are eligible, your <u>voucher</u> will then be sent to the Ballarat Denture Clinic.
- 2. Once registered with the Oral Health Department at CHRH, you will be required to phone the Ballarat Denture Clinic on: 5331 6486 to arrange an appointment time for your impression in Ballarat. The BDC is located at 18 Raglan Street North, Ballarat.
- You will be able to collect your mouthguard from CHRH Community Health and Wellbeing Centre within 7-14 days after your impression.
